

## LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Dec. 20, 2021, to Sunday, Jan. 2, 2022, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 377 response calls during this period. ### Monday, Dec. 20
