

## LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, June 28, to Sunday, July 4, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 235 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

### Monday, June 28

- **Mount Hope/Green roads, ATL/BOLO** – Patrol responded to a call from the Erie County Sheriff's Office. No further information.
- **1600 block of Ridge Road, MVA-property damage** – Caller to 911 reported a two-vehicle property damage only accident with a Modern Disposal truck.
