

The following activity occurred Monday, May 30 to Sunday, June 5, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 265 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

**Monday, May 30**
