

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, June 7, to Sunday, June 13, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 174 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

- Monday, June 7**
- **100 block of Morrow Plaza, assist** – New York State Parks Police reported an unconscious party in a vehicle, possibly asleep. Male subject not responding to knocks on the vehicle window; a parks ranger reported he was moving. Subject conscious and alert.
 - **5700 block of West Street, police services** – Officer initiated call. Patrols on location; no issues reported at a protest event; group has dispersed.
 - **2900 block of Niagara Street, animal complaint** – Caller to 911 reported a dog crying inside an apartment. Caller said the residents appeared to have moved and were last seen a week earlier. Patrol obtained the phone number of the dog's owner and left a voicemail.
 - **800 block of Swann Road, MVA-injuries** – Caller to 911 reported a female, 53, was ejected following a side-by-side accident/vehicle rollover. Subject has rib and shoulder injuries, head pain and difficulty breathing. Patrols on location.

a female making numerous calls threatening hospital staff. Subject was in the ER earlier and verbally abusive towards staff.
