

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, June 8, to Sunday, June 14, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 214 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's new mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, June 8

- **900 block of Mohawk Street, domestic disturbance** – Patrol responded to a 911 call from a male. No report taken.
- **4300 block of Ransomville Road, traffic complaint/investigation** – Caller to 911 reported a vehicle all over the roadway. Vehicle listed as blue Dodge Ram 4x4 had just pulled into a driveway. Patrols on location, one female in custody for driving while intoxicated. Miranda and DWI warnings read. Report taken.
