

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, May 10, to Sunday, May 16, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 206 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

- Monday, May 10**
- **LPD office, forgery** – Officer initiated call. Patrols on location for complaint.
 - **3500 block of Ransomville Road, mental health check** – Patrol responded to a 911 call.
 - **5500 block of Walmore Road, harassment** – Patrols responded to a 911 call. No further information.
 - **2100 block of Upper Mountain Road, harassment** – Caller to 911 reported harassment issues among family members. Report only.
