

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Nov. 8, to Sunday, Nov. 14, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 183 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

- Monday, Nov. 8**
- **4900 block of Callan Drive, drug investigation, vehicle/traffic stop and domestic disturbance** – Patrol responded to three 911 response calls at the address. One suspect in custody for driving while intoxicated; 12-hour hold placed on vehicle, tow requested.
 - **1700 block of Ridge Road, animal complaint** – Caller reported an owl found on the side of the road, possibly injured. Animal secured.
 - **1800 block of Sweet Home Road, theft** – Patrol reported a walk-in complaint. Male, 76, stated an unknown subject entered an unlocked shed and took two welding tanks that were on a dolly. No charges wished; male wanted to make patrol aware of the incident. Report taken. Patrol cleared.

 - **Kenneth Avenue/Lewiston Road, MVA-property damage** – Caller reported two vehicles off to the side of the roadway; no injuries. MV form completed by patrol; drivers provided information exchange forms. One driver cited for moving from a lane unsafely; uniform traffic ticket issued for Lewiston Town Court. Patrol cleared.
 - **5300 block of Military Road, Mount St. Mary's Hospital, disturbance non-domestic** –

Caller to 911 reported a female patient needed to be removed from the ER. Hospital switchboard contacted patrol to remove subject.

- **500 block of Fairway Drive, domestic disturbance, non-domestic and assist public** – On first response, male caller sought patrol's assistance to remove property. Second call, the male reported a female was going crazy about him removing property. Parties separated on third response; no weapons or intoxication. Patrol handled.
