

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Oct. 19, to Thursday, Oct. 29, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

- Monday, Oct. 19**
- 500 block of Mountain View Drive, fire** – Caller to 911 reported hearing a large bang and observing flames and smoke from trees. Per State Police a controlled burn and on fire on location; responders not needed.
