

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Oct. 4, to Sunday, Oct. 10, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 189 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook

- Monday, Oct. 4**
- **Old Lewiston Road/Irving Drive, suspicious activity** – Caller to 911 reported a party was starting a "camp fire" at the old train tunnel. NYPA requested fire responders for a grass fire. Patrols responded; report taken.
 - **5900 block of Walmore Road, vehicle/traffic stop** – Officer initiated call. Patrol reported the driver as showing suspended; four scoffs to date. One female in custody.
 - **Niagara Scenic Parkway/Pletcher Road, traffic complaint** – Officer initiated call. Debris in the roadway; a large tree limb was removed by patrol.
