

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Sept. 14, to Sunday, Sept. 20, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 186 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, Sept. 14

- **500 block of Mountainview Drive, domestic disturbance (two responses)** – Patrols responded to a 911 call. No further information.
- **Legacy Drive/Creek Road, harassment** – Caller reported the driver of a vehicle accelerated towards him at another work site; ongoing problem.
- **4200 block of Lower River Road, trespass** – Caller to 911 reported an unwanted party on the school grounds. Caller said the staff told the male party multiple times to leave the premises. Patrol said the male was attempting to see his child and was asked to leave. No charges at this time.
