

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Oct. 5, to Sunday, Oct. 11, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 199 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, Oct. 5

- **Location not listed, assist** – Female caller to 911 reported being out of gas and no service. Driver in a silver Corolla; patrol gave the female \$10 for gas and sent her on her way. Call cleared.
- **2300 block of Printup Road, disturbance, non-domestic** – Patrols responded to a 911 call.
- **1000 block of Sweet Home Road, harassment** – Caller to 911 reported adults causing problems for each other on Facebook.
- **Walmore/Saunders Settlement roads, check welfare** – Caller to 911 reported a possible rolling domestic. Vehicle listed as a light blue Volkswagen Jetta; plate number logged.
