

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Sept. 6, to Sunday, Sept. 12, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 249 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook

- Monday, Sept. 6**
- **5300 block of Military Road, Mount St. Mary's Hospital, disturbance non-domestic** – Hospital ER staff reported an unruly female patient. ER Security requesting patrol to assist.
 - **1200 block of Saunders Settlement Road, check welfare** – Patrols responded to a 911 call; no further information. Report taken.
