

## LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, Sept. 13, to Sunday, Sept. 19, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 233 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

### Monday, Sept. 13

- **Hyde Park Boulevard/North Avenue, vehicle/traffic stop** – Officer initiated call. Patrol reported one male in custody on following charges: aggravated unlicensed operation, third; unlicensed operator; failure to yield right of way, emergency vehicle; operating/permitting operation without insurance; unregistered motor vehicle; improper plates; no/insufficient tail lamps; and uninspected motor vehicle. Appearance and uniform traffic tickets issued for Lewiston Town Court.
- **800 block of Oriole Lane, domestic disturbance** – Patrols responded to a 911 call; no further information. Report taken.
- **Center/N. Ninth streets, suspicious activity** – Caller reported a male with a red shirt and jeans near the Niagara River Region Chamber office building with a machete. Patrols on location.
- **500 block of Irving Drive, assist public** – Caller to 911 reported the landlord changed the locks; caller unable to enter residence and landlord not on the property. Patrol located the landlord who said locks were not changed and a key will be provided to the tenant after he done cutting the grass.
- **300 block of S. Third Street, animal complaint** – Caller to 911 reported a barking dog problem, ongoing issue. Dogs are outside all the time and constantly barking. Patrol attempted to locate homeowner, with negative results; vehicle in driveway and dogs now in the house.
- **800 block of Balmer Road, suspicious activity** – Caller reported walking by the address for three days in a row and seeing a male on the front lawn/driveway, naked. Patrol responded; no further

information.

- **200 block of Portage Road, assist public** – Caller to 911 reported the landlord changed the locks while he was sleeping; caller now unable to lock the residence and leave for work.
- **5800 block of Kline Road, harassment** – Caller reported a neighbor keeps throwing trash alongside the fence. Patrol spoke with both parties; civil matter. Parties advised to stay off each other's property and ignore each other.
- **700 block of Cayuga Street, disturbance non-domestic** – Caller to 911 reported two males at a bar/restaurant business who refused to pay their bill; subjects sitting at the bar, no weapons/intoxication. Patrol said the mother of one the males came to the business and paid their tab. Patrol cleared.
- **Saunders Settlement/Military roads, damage to property** – Caller to 911 reported a water main break. Male said he was digging and struck a pipe, resulting in large amount of water coming out of the ground. Town of Niagara DPW on location.

### Tuesday, Sept. 14

- **5800 block of Buffalo Street, suspicious activity** – Officer initiated call. Patrol spoke with a driver who was driving slowly through the neighborhood; subject stated he was playing Pokémon Go.
- **4000 block of Ridgeview Avenue, animal complaint** – Caller to 911 reported multiple dogs in and out of the roadway. SPCA on location to secure fence; one dog leashed. SPCA to seek warrant for six other dogs.
- **Washington Drive/Madison Avenue, traffic complaint** – Officer initiated call. Complaint of a motorcycle operating on the roadway, driver without a helmet. Subject GOA.
- **University Drive, disturbance non-domestic** – Caller to 911 reported a male wearing a white T-shirt; subject is combative and refusing to leave. Patrol spoke with the male who said he was waiting for

a bus ride home. Patrol provided courtesy transport to the male's residence. Call cleared.

- **Academy Park, Center Street** – disturbance, non-domestic – Officer initiated call. Possible fight; male became aggressive toward park staff. Upon arrival male was sitting down and cooperative. Patrol said the male was intoxicated and heading "back to the bunkhouse."
- **4400 block of Creek Road, damage to property** – Caller reported a mailbox was struck and the vehicle left the scene. Patrol contacted the transportation company of said vehicle; driver to be contacted and payment of damages handled.
- **Lower Mountain/Townline roads, traffic complaint** – Male caller to 911 reported being followed by another male, who is also making threats. Patrols responded.
- **Saunders Settlement/Mayflower roads, vehicle/traffic stop** – Officer initiated call. One male in custody for aggravated unlicensed operation; suspect released on an appearance ticket for Lewiston Town Court.

### Wednesday, Sept. 15

- **4900 block of Ridgeview Avenue, assist** – Caller to 911 requested patrol assist SPCA agents on a search warrant of a vacated home; officers assisted with removal of eight dogs. Town code enforcement officer notified of living conditions at residence and exposed electrical wiring inside.
- **Saunders Settlement/Shawnee roads, suspicious activity** – Officer initiated call. Caller reported a red Saturn SUV, reckless operation. Vehicle travelling at a high rate of speed; patrol unable to locate.
- **2200 block of Saunders Settlement Road, Niagara Wheatfield High School, suspicious activity** – Officer initiated call. School administration suspected four students were smoking marijuana or vaping in boys' restroom. Officials conducted an investigation and search of the students' backpacks with patrol present, negative

results reported. No actions from patrol necessary.

- **5300 block of Military Road, Mount St. Mary's Hospital, domestic disturbance** – Patrols responded to a 911 call. No further information.
- **5900 block of Tuscarora Road, animal complaint** – Caller reported on ongoing problem of dogs barking nonstop since earlier in the morning; possibly four dogs are on the property.
- **1100 block of Saunders Settlement Road, forgery** – Caller reported state unemployment benefits were being claimed in her name. Report taken.
- **5300 block of Military Road, disturbance non-domestic** – Caller to 911 reported a female party causing an issue, possibly related to an earlier call. Patrols said the patient's daughter was causing a scene, requiring a charge nurse to contact the hospital's Risk Management to address the problem.
- **Lewiston/Military roads, vehicle/traffic stop** – Officer initiated call. Patrol reported a vehicle travelling at 85 mph, failure to yield. Officer said the driver had caught off other vehicles in heavy traffic. No further information on charges.
- **Locations on the 800 and 1000 blocks of Upper Mountain Road and at Military/Annover roads, vehicle/traffic stops** – Calls officer initiated. Violations per stop were first two drivers, speed in zone; and driver, uninspected motor vehicle. Uniform traffic tickets issued for Lewiston Town Court.
