

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, July 4, to Sunday, July 10, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 191 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, July 4

- **Lewiston Queenston Bridge, assist** – 911 caller reported an individual made the wrong turn at bridge and was possibly in possession of drugs. Patrol responded; subject was taken into custody on multiple charges.
