

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, June 27, to Sunday, July 3, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 194 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, June 27

- **1600 block of Braley Road, ordinance violation** – Caller reported "very large and loud fireworks" at the location. No interview requested.
- **5100 block of Country Club Trail, alarm burglary** – Alarm provider reported an alarm going off in the garage and front door of the residence. Patrol spoke with homeowner; all secure.
