

LEWISTON POLICE BLOTTER

The following activity occurred Monday, June 13, to Sunday, June 19, as reported by the Lewiston Police Department. LPD reported 208 response calls during this period. For more information on arrests and other activity, visit the Lewiston Police Department's mobile app or its page on Facebook.

Monday, June 13

- **5100 block of Homestead Place, suspicious activity** – Officer initiated call. Caller reported hearing a loud scream. Patrol checked the area with negative results.
